

INDICATION

What is VOWST? VOWST is a prescription medicine used to prevent *Clostridioides difficile* (*C. diff*) infection from coming back in people 18 years of age or older after antibiotic treatment for *C. diff* infection has been completed.

VOWST is not intended for treatment of *C. diff* infection.

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Do not take VOWST at the same time as antibiotics. VOWST contains live bacteria and antibiotics can interfere with VOWST.

Swallow each capsule whole. DO NOT crush, chew, or break the capsule. See Patient Information for complete information about how to take VOWST.

YOU DID NOTHING WRONG TO GET C. DIFF

C. diff can happen to anyone, but there are certain factors that can increase your risk of it coming back

- Taking antibiotics
- A Being 65 years of age or older
- Staying in a hospital or nursing home
- Having a weakened immune system
- Ouse of proton-pump inhibitor (PPI) therapy for acid reflux
- A Being exposed to C. diff germs



While antibiotics can kill *C. diff* bacteria, they are a main risk factor for getting a recurrence

After you've had *C. diff* at least 2 times, your risk of it coming back again increases up to 65%

When *C. diff* comes back, you may recognize some common symptoms. Talk to your doctor if you are having*:



Frequent, uniquely bad-smelling diarrhea



Painful stomach cramps



Fever



Nausea and loss of appetite

^{*}These are the common recurrent *C. diff* symptoms, but not all possible symptoms.

The role of antibiotics in *C. diff*



Antibiotics are an important piece of treatment because they kill C. diff bacteria that cause your infection

Unfortunately, antibiotics do not restore the balance of good and bad bacteria in your gut, which can lead to another *C. diff* recurrence



Your intestine is full of trillions of bacteria that make up the gut microbiome

The most common side effects of VOWST are:

- bloated abdomen
 constipation
 diarrhea

Why the balance of good and bad bacteria is important



In a healthy gut microbiome, good and bad bacteria are balanced



But if your gut gets disrupted, your body's natural defense against *C. diff* is weakened



This causes some people to get C. diff again and again

VOWST can help prevent another recurrence



HOW DOES VOWST WORK?



VOWST is believed to work in the following way to prevent recurrent *C. diff*



IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION (CONTINUED)

Before taking VOWST, tell your doctor about all your medical conditions, including if you: have kidney disease because you may not be able to take the magnesium citrate laxative; or have any other medical conditions now or have had before, are pregnant or planning to get pregnant, or are breastfeeding.

Tell your doctor about all the medicines you take, including prescription and over-the-counter medicines, vitamins, and supplements.

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C. DIFF DOESN'T HAVE TO COME BACK AGAIN

A clinical study showed that 2 months after taking VOWST, most people were recurrence free and continued to be even 6 months later

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compared to 6 out of 10 people taking antibiotics alone



STILL RECURRENCE FREE AT 6 MONTHS

compared to 5 out of 10 people taking antibiotics alone



MOST COMMON SIDE EFFECTS OF VOWST

VOWST was generally well tolerated—the most common side effects were mild to moderate

In a clinical study, these side effects were seen in people taking VOWST and people taking antibiotics alone

	People taking VOWST	People taking ANTIBIOTICS ALONE
Bloated abdomen	31%	29%
Fatigue	22%	22%
Constipation	14%	11%
Chills	11%	8%
Diarrhea	10%	4%



These are not all the possible side effects of VOWST—be sure to tell your doctor about any side effect that bothers you or does not go away

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HOW DO I TAKE VOWST?

There are 3 steps to taking VOWST

ANTIBIOTICS Finish the full course of antibiotics

Within 1-3 days of finishing antibiotics

LAXATIVE Drink 10 ounces of a laxative (magnesium citrate)

Tell your doctor if you have kidney disease because you may not be able to take the magnesium citrate laxative

Do not eat or drink (except for a small amount of water) for at least 8 hours before starting your 1st dose of VOWST-for example, fast overnight

The next day after laxative

Take VOWST before your first meal on an empty stomach

VOWST is 4 capsules taken orally once a day for 3 days in a row







Swallow each capsule whole. DO NOT crush, chew, or break the capsules. Do not take VOWST at the same time as antibiotics or the laxative

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Using a laxative is important because it helps clear out leftover antibiotics from your gut so that VOWST can work properly



CASE MANAGER CALL

After your doctor helps enroll you in the VOWST Voyage Support Program, a case manager will verify whether VOWST is covered under your insurance plan and let you know which specialty pharmacy will ship your VOWST prescription



WELCOME KIT SHIPMENT

Next, the case manager will contact you to answer any questions you may have about the program and coordinate the shipment of a welcome kit, which may contain your laxative, directly to your home



DELIVERY SCHEDULING

Finally, you will receive a scheduling call for your VOWST prescription—it is very important you answer the call to accept your VOWST shipment



DOSING TEXT REMINDERS

Once you get your shipment of VOWST, you'll get helpful text message reminders each time you should take a dose of VOWST (you will only receive text messages if you opt in to receive them)
